Cyclical Resets of Human Civilization Every 5,000

Years: Evidence from Ancient Texts and

Archaeological Records

Abstract

I propose that every 5,000 years, human civilization undergoes a catastrophic reset through massive disasters or global wars, erasing advanced societies and restarting humanity from scraps. This cycle is evident from the absence of above-ground structures predating the Great Pyramids of Giza (circa 2550 BCE), the global scale of wars in the Mahabharata and Ramayana, and their use of scientific weapons akin to nuclear bombs and rocket launchers. Archaeological remnants of extinct civilizations, found only in excavations or seas, support this hypothesis. My prior research on the Brahmastra as a nuclear weapon, Lord Ramas existence in 40,000 BC, Shivas Bow as a rocket launcher, and humans as biobots controlled by divine forces provides a foundation for this cyclical model. The Mahabharata and Ramayana depict global conflicts, not local wars, with kings from across the world using advanced weaponry. As humanity reaches a technological peak in the current cycle, moral degradation, as prophesied in the Bhagavata Purana, Quran, and Bible, signals an impending reset through self-inflicted wars, as seen in current global conflicts like Ukraine-Russia and Iran-Israel.

1 Introduction

I propose that human civilization follows a 5,000-year cycle where societies rise from scraps to technological peaks, become morally corrupt, and are reset by massive disasters or world wars. This generation, aware of figures like Socrates, Ashoka, Alexander, Wells, Shakespeare, Newton, and Hawking, has existed for approximately 5,000 years, and its completion signals an imminent end. My prior research establishes that humanity achieves god-like scientific prowess every 5,000 years, only to be destroyed by wars or disasters due to moral corruption, acting as a divine population control mechanism. Specifically, I reference: - Brahmastra as a Nuclear Weapon [1]. - Lord Rama Existed in 40,000 BC [2]. - Unveiling the Shiva Bow as an Advanced Technological Weapon [3]. - Humans as Biobots [4].

No known above-ground structures predate the Great Pyramids of Giza (circa 2550 BCE, approximately 4,500 years old), and older structures, linked to extinct civilizations, are found only in excavations or seas. The Mahabharata and Ramayana describe global wars, not small conflicts, involving kings from across the world with weapons akin to nuclear bombs, missiles, and firearms. These wars likely spanned continents, with narratives localized to India as people migrated. The rapid scientific rise post-1500 CE, after 3,500 years of minimal progress, mirrors past cycles. Older structures, such as Göbekli Tepe (9600-7000 BCE) or submerged sites like Dwarka (potentially 7500 BCE), belong to extinct civilizations and are found only through excavation or underwater exploration. For example: - The Mundeshwari

Temple (circa 108 CE), one of the oldest Hindu temples, is far younger than the pyramids. - The Dura-Europos church (circa 233 CE) and Quba Mosque (622 CE) are even more recent. - Submerged sites like Dwarka or Yonaguni indicate advanced civilizations drowned in seas, supporting the reset hypothesis.

This absence suggests a global catastrophe around 3000 BCE, erasing prior civilizations above-ground legacy. If humanity digs deeper, I predict multiple layers of submerged continents with advanced artifacts, indicating repeated cycles of rise and fall.

3 Global Wars in Mahabharata and Ramayana

The Mahabharata and Ramayana are not accounts of small conflicts between Indian states but global wars involving kings and armies from across the world. Their narratives were adapted to Indian landmarks as people migrated, preserving stories in a relatable context.

3.1 Ramayana: A Global Coalition

The Ramayana describes Ramas war against Ravana, involving billions of Vanaras and kings from diverse regions:

sa samudra iva gambhrah aila iva durnivryah | vanarnm sahasrni niyutni ca ktitah || (Valmiki Ramayana, Yuddha Kanda, 6.4.17)

Translation: Like the ocean, deep and irresistible like a mountain, thousands and millions of Vanaras gathered.

The Vanaras, numbering in billions, likely represent a global coalition of tribes or nations, not literal monkeys, gathered from all parts of the earth. Ravanas allies, including Rakshasas and kings from distant lands, fought alongside him, suggesting a worldwide conflict. I propose this war spanned continents. People migrating to India localized the narrative to sites like Ayodhya and Lanka [2].

3.2 Mahabharata: A World-Spanning Conflict

The Mahabharatas Kurukshetra war involved kings from the entire world:

denm ca vieea samantt prthivtmajh | samgat mahtmnah kuruketre samantatah || (Mahabharata, Adi Parva, 1.185.3)

Translation: Kings, the sons of rulers from various regions, great souls, assembled at Kurukshetra from all directions.

Participants included Gandharas (Afghanistan), Kambojas (Central Asia), and Yavanas (Greeks), indicating a global scale. The wars magnitude, with millions of warriors, precludes a local conflict. I propose it occurred across vast continents, with Kurukshetra as a symbolic focal point in later Indian retellings.

4 Scientific Weapons in Ancient Wars

The divine weapons in the Mahabharata and Ramayana were not magical but highly scientific, akin to nuclear weapons, missiles, and firearms, as detailed in my prior works [1, 3].

4.1 Brahmastra as a Nuclear Weapon

The Brahmastra caused effects resembling nuclear explosions:

divya tejo mahad dptam brahmstra prdurst | arreu ca sarvem dahyamneu vryavn || (Mahabharata, Drona Parva, 7.202.12)

Translation: A divine, radiant weapon, the Brahmastra, blazed forth, burning the bodies of all with its power.

Its blinding light, intense heat, and environmental devastation mirror nuclear fallout, as I argued in [1]. Similar weapons were used by warriors like Bhishma, Drona, Ashwatthama, and Duryodhana, indicating widespread advanced technology.

4.2 Gandiva and Shivas Bow as Firearms

Arjunas Gandiva and Ramas use of Shivas Bow were advanced firearms:

gva dhanur utka divya sanadati svanaih | arair agni-samkrair jvaladbhir iva pvakaih | (Mahabharata, Virata Parva, 4.43.5)

Translation: The Gandiva, a divine bow, resounded with fiery arrows blazing like fire.

The fiery arrows suggest explosive projectiles, akin to missiles. Shivas Bow, as I demonstrated, functioned as a rocket launcher [3]. These weapons sophistication indicates a technological peak comparable to modern warfare.

5 Evidence of Extinct Civilizations

Archaeological findings reveal advanced civilizations from previous cycles, now extinct and buried: - Göbekli Tepe (96007000 BCE): Complex stone structures in Turkey, predating the pyramids, suggesting advanced engineering. - Dwarka (potentially 7500 BCE): Submerged off Indias coast, with urban structures indicating a sophisticated society. - Yonaguni Monument (circa 8000 BCE): Submerged off Japan, possibly a man-made pyramid.

These remnants, found only in excavations or seas, support the hypothesis of multiple civilizational layers. If humanity digs further, I predict discovering continents drowned in seas with multiple civilizations buried under layers, each representing a 5,000-year cycle.

6 Rapid Scientific Rise and Moral Degradation

The current cycle, beginning around 3000 BCE, saw minimal scientific progress for 3,500 years, with a sudden rise post-1500 CE. This mirrors past cycles, where humanity reached god-like scientific prowess before collapse. Translation: In Kali Yuga, righteousness stands on one leg, unrighteousness grows, and great destruction follows sin.

The Quran states: When the sky is cleft asunder (Surah Al-Infitar, 82:12), interpretable as missile strikes, as seen in Ukraine-Russia conflict videos at night. Jesus words, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place (Matthew 24:34), and calling humans sheep (John 10:27), suggest he viewed each 5,000-year cycle as a single generation, manipulated by divine forces [4].

7 Parallels with Past Cycles

Ancient texts describe societies at technological peaks before destruction: - **Sodom and Gomorrah**: They did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded (Luke 17:2829). Eating and drinking (pizza, burgers, whiskey) mirrors modern consumerism. Planting trees indicates pollution awareness, and building grand structures parallels modern skyscrapers. Their destruction by fire and brimstone (Genesis 19:24), with brimstone as sulfur (used in gunpowder), suggests advanced weaponry, possibly nuclear, leaving desertification and salt residues. - **Noahs Time**: They were eating and drinking, marrying and being given in marriage (Matthew 24:38). The great flood, akin to Manus flood, ended their cycle. - **Ramas Time**: Surpanakhas traits resemble modern feminists, and Ravanas society mirrors todays moral decay. Ramas fight against pollution and use of ultra-scientific weapons, alongside Ravanas people protecting dinosaurs, indicate a technological peak [2].

8 Impending Reset and Prophecies
